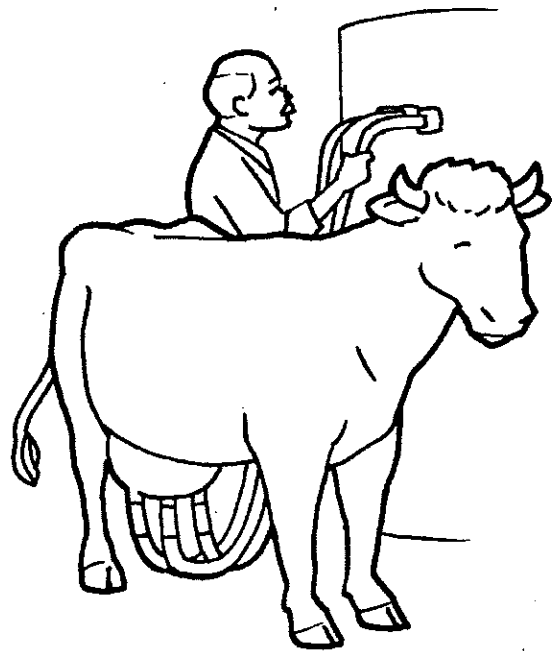

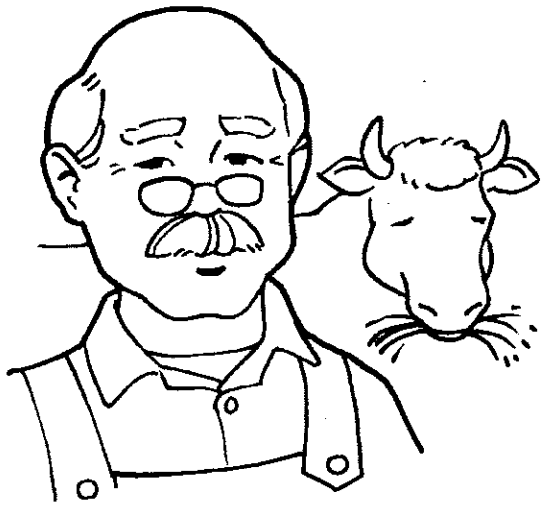

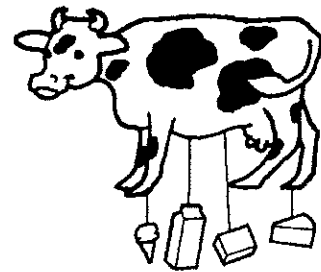

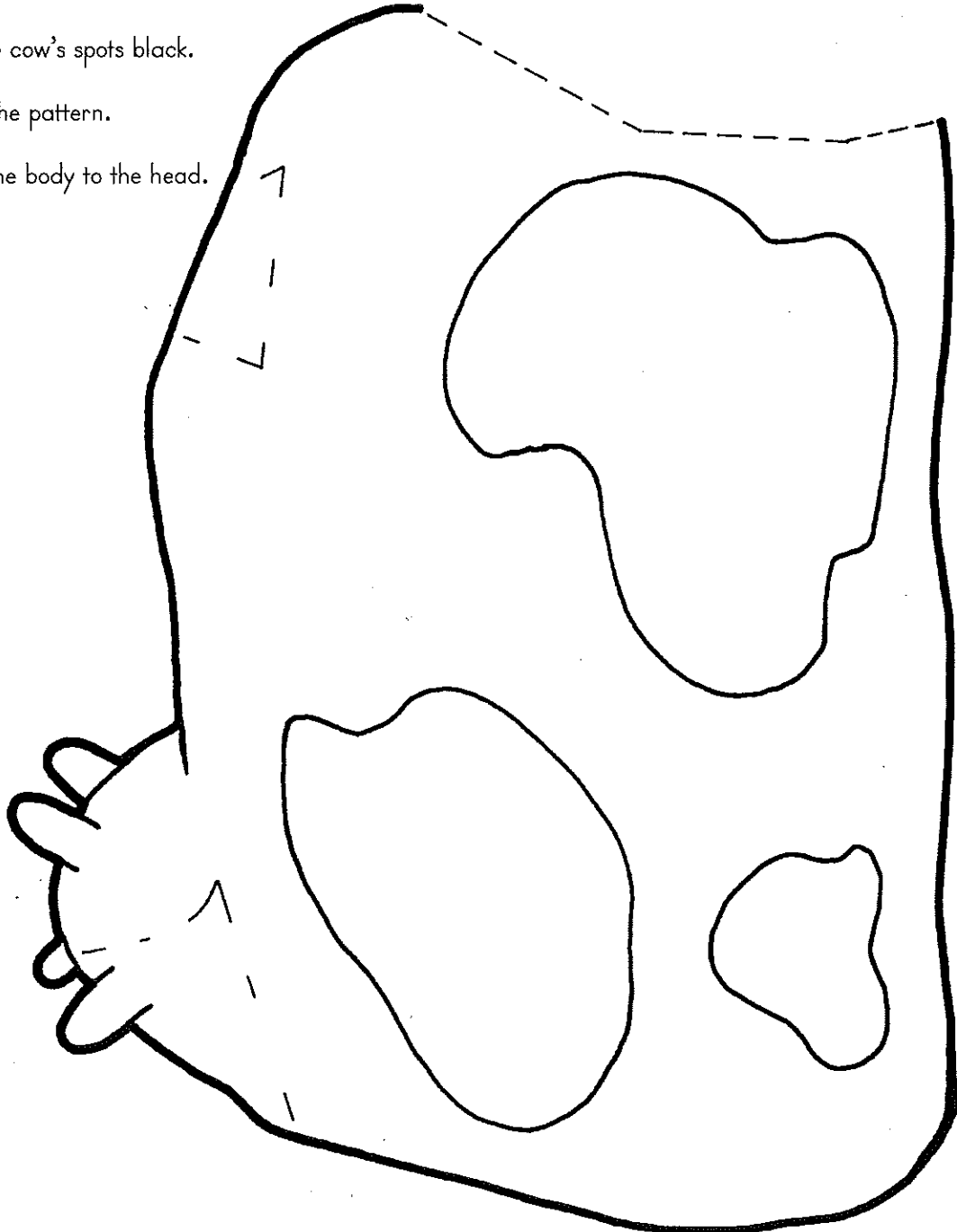
Producer to Consumer Pattern

3. Attach the body to the head.



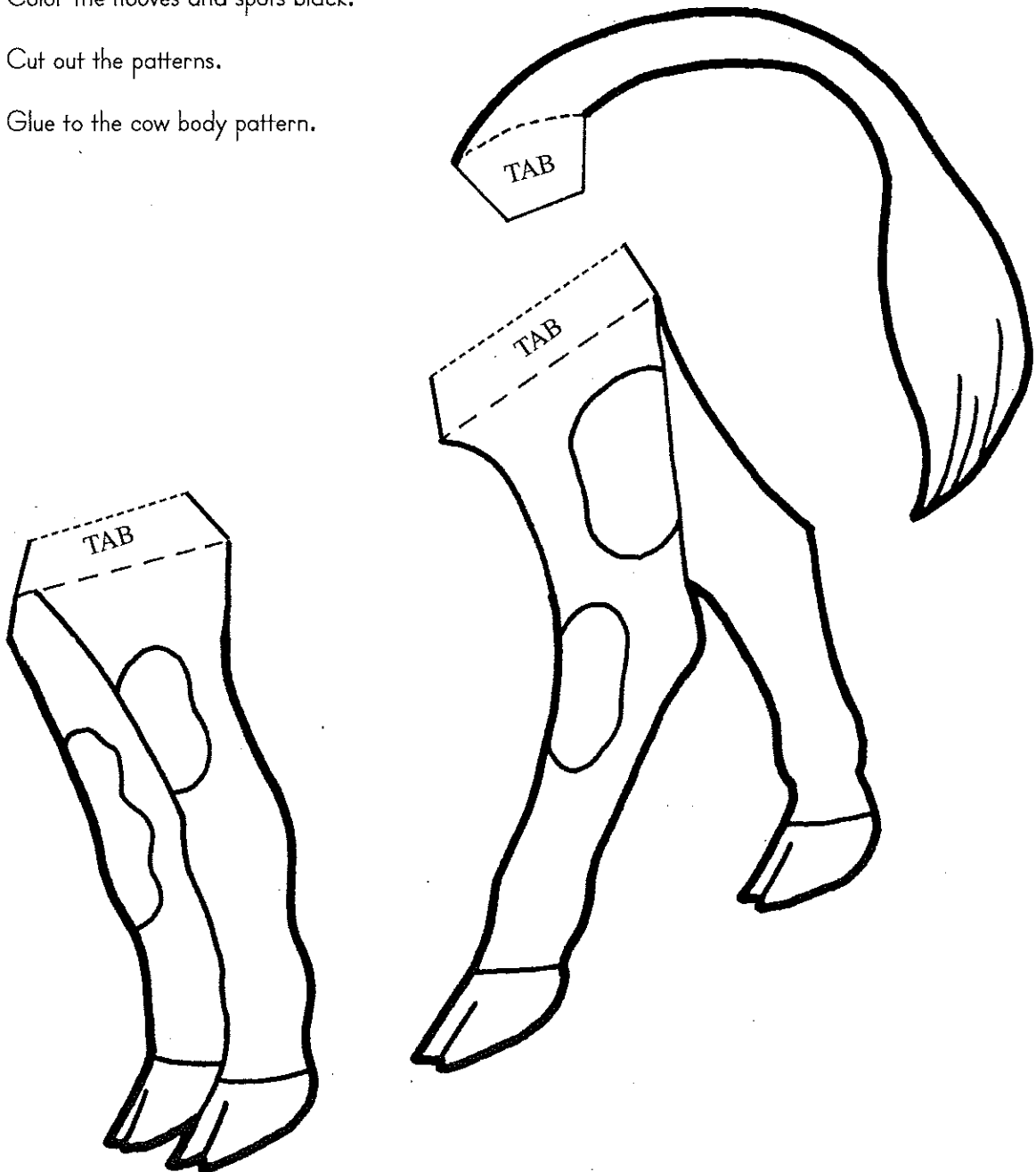
Producer to Consumer Pattern
