5. Matters of Public Comment

6A. Discuss and Vote on Communication to the Governor's Office Regarding Amendment to SB264 Banning Gun Shows Solely at OC Fair & Event Center

On January 27, 2021 California State Senator Dave Min introduced SB264 prohibiting gun shows on any state or county property. Since the bill was introduced it was amended to exclude county property from the bill and include only state property. On June 1, 2021, the bill passed the senate by a vote of 29-9 and was ordered to the assembly.

While in committee with the assembly, the bill was further amended to only impact the OC Fair & Event Center. SB264 was approved by the assembly appropriations committee. The full assembly approved the bill as amended 43-17 on September 2 and the bill was referred back to the senate for approval.



6A. Discuss and Vote on Communication to the Governor's Office Regarding Amendment to SB264 Banning Gun Shows Solely at OC Fair & Event Center

The senate passed the amended bill the following day on Sept. 3 by a vote of 28-9. The bill is now on the Governor's desk for signature and he has until October 10 to sign. If he does not sign it or amend it by then, the bill will become California law and go into effect January 1, 2022.

The Board will discuss the status of SB264 and whether or not to send a letter to the Governor respectfully requesting he veto SB264 because it exclusively targets the 32nd DAA. It is also important to make the Governor aware of the economic impact this decision has on the 32nd DAA and the local economy.

6B. Discuss and Vote on Whether or Not to Approve 2022 Rental Agreements with Crossroads of the West Gun Show to Exclude Sale of Firearm Precursor Parts

SB264, the bill banning gun shows at the OC Fair & Event Center, was passed by both the state senate and assembly and is now on the Governor's desk for signature.

An exemption in the bill excludes any rental agreements that are in place prior to the bill's effective date of January 1, 2021. The Crossroads of the West Gun Shows requested that OCFEC consider pre-approving its rental agreements for 2022 to allow transition time for the promoter to find a new location for the gun shows. The promoter also acknowledged prior conversations by the Board regarding firearm precursor parts used to make "ghost guns," and has offered to consider eliminating those exhibitors from its 2022 shows if approved.
