WHAT IS THE RANCH COMMUNITY CENTER?

The Ranch Community Center's (The Ranch) vision is to advance OC Fair & Event Center's (OCFEC) mission of "creating equitable community access to agriculture, entertainment, cultural and educational experiences." The goal of The Ranch is to create a positive impact through programs highlighting equine, ranching and nature to a diverse community. It will promote learning, wellness, health and joy through various experiences.

WHAT PROGRAMS ARE OFFERED AT THE RANCH?

OCFEC is creating exhibits to promote all things equine to educate the public on a variety of subjects, including horse care, utilization, horse-related careers and other equine-related activities.

Using Centennial Farm as a model, we are developing a variety of programs to include walk-through exhibits, equine assisted therapy working with accredited and licensed therapists (EAGALA and/or PATH certified), educational tours, hands-on experiences with horses, public horse shows and clinics, and more.

WILL PROGRAMS BE FREE FOR THE PUBLIC TO ATTEND?

Similar to OCFEC's other community give-back programs like Centennial Farm, Heroes Hall and Imaginology, most programs and events will be free to the public.
